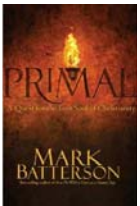
Sundays

An exciting ten part study on the Ten Commandments. Ed Young brings a fresh approach to the classic issues of the Ten Commandments and how they are still relevant for today.

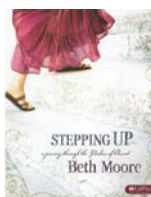

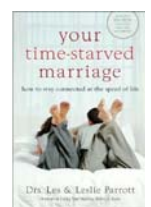
(THUR 02) "Building With Christ" Ingram

General 7:00pm Littlestown [Tim Harrison]

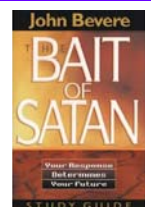
This 6-8 week study will focus on hot topics in marriage such as communication, sex, and understanding our differences from a humorous point of view.
